Plan

Motion: That the Project Plans for Taylor as approved by email be ratified

> The Taylors' own a cattle-grazing property at the head of the Obi Obi Creek catchment, with 450 m of frontage to Obi Obi Creek. Currently the livestock have unrestricted access to the riparian zone. The project aims to support the Taylor farm to remove livestock from the riparian zone and improve the riparian buffer through revegetation and the installation of concrete crossings. Healthy riparian buffers assist in the filtering of runoff and the removal of nutrients and pathogens, before entering

Obi Obi Creek and ultimately Lake Baroon.

The Taylor property is a moderate to low priority property based on its distance to Baroon Pocket Dam off take tower. However, the significance of this project is increased by the land use, riparian health, and the landholder's readiness to implement projects. Furthermore, the significance of the project is increased due to the importance of the Obi Obi Creek in the Lake Baroon catchment, and the volume of previous, planned and current projects undertaken in the surrounding area by Lake

The Sayers' own a cattle-grazing property at the head of the Obi Obi Creek catchment, with 300 m of frontage to Obi Obi Creek. Currently the livestock have unrestricted access to the riparian zone. The project aims to support the Sayer farm to remove livestock from the riparian zone and improve the riparian buffer through fencing, revegetation and off stream water. Healthy riparian buffers assist in the filtering of runoff and the removal of nutrients and pathogens, before entering Obi Obi Creek and ultimately Lake Baroon.

The Sayer property is a moderate to low priority property based on its distance to Baroon Pocket Dam off take tower. However, the significance of this project is increased by the land use, riparian health, and the landholder's readiness to implement projects.
