- Top priority given remaining funding
- Hot wet summer has provided ideal growing conditions
- Flowering season useful in giving “full scope” of infestation sites

Fisher Road, Peachester- Madeira Flowering



Fisher Rd, Peachester- Following Treatment





- Disrupts infestation sites
- Exposes MV ground tubers
- Deposits vines and tubers downstream
- Spreads waterweeds from overflowing dams
- Site management timing important

Flood Debris Deposit (Salvinia and Water Lettuce) Running Creek, Stanmore





Seqwater Weeds

- Lots of sites at different stages of management
- Continuing to rotate through sites per schedule
- Flooding has led to secondary infestations appearing in new locations
